See *Erythea* 3(5): 73 (1895) for original description, *Phytoneuron* 2012-39: 1-60 (2012) for revised nomenclature, *Phytoneuron* 40: 1-123 (2012) for taxonomic treatment, and *Phytoneuron* 2013-67: 1-15 (2013) for new distribution records.
