Notes

Federally listed as Endangered on 1977-09-12, Delisted due to Recovery on 2023-02-24. Feral herbivores removed from SCM Isl., and vegetation recovering. Dubiously distinct from *D. variegatum* in *Phytologia* 68(1):1-3 (1990); may be difficult to distinguish from ssp. *thornei*. USFWS uses the name *D. kinkiense* ssp. *kinkiense*. See *Aliso* 7:69 (1969) for original description, and *Madroño* 47(2):116-126 (2000) for discussion of separation from ssp. *thornei*.
