Previously on List 1B.1. Taxonomic distinctiveness from *D. harfordii* is uncertain; needs further study. Last seen on SCM Isl. in 1966. Threatened by feral herbivores. Most of the year a few plants are in flower. A synonym of *D. harfordii* in *TJM* (1993) and *TJM* 2. USFWS uses the name *D. rigida* ssp. *rhamnoides*.
